



Configuration

1. **Gated Overlay Anchor ID** – Provide the Overlay's anchor ID.
2. **Container Aria Label** – Provide a meaningful aria label for this component.
3. **Close Aria Label** – This field is not required to be authored. This field will be removed in future.
4. **Close Overlay Label** – This field is not required to be authored. This field will be removed in future.
5. **AEM Form Path** – The AEM form path should be configured to display overlay. As a pre-requisite to display overlay, a form must be created or an existing form can be used, and that path must be configured here.


Step 1: Creation of Form



- i) '**minimizedTopPanel**' css to be configured on Title Panel




ii) '*minimizedBottomPanel*' css to be configured on Submit Panel
