2.1 Short Description

This component is used to path Users to Article Detail pages - package related articles, to engage the users to spend more time on the Website content. It includes Image, Headline, Article title, and Read time – entire Square including the Image, Title, and Headline is clickable and navigates User to the destination

Feature Overview

All Photos on this component is Author provided, gradient treatment/darkening to be applied via AEM

Following rules are enforced:

• Recommended Desktop Image 405px width

Headline

Article Headline

Read Time

Read time for the Article

Following rules are enforced:

- Carousel functionality should snap next article into view port
- View port is the article that fully displays on the graphical background

If less than 4 articles, remove carousel arrows

This Module requires a minimum of 3 articles

When more than 4 articles, keep carousel arrows active. Carousel should be an infinite loop

 Only activate click through on articles that are fully in view. When clicking on articles that are cut-off by the browser, snap that article into the view port

Interaction Alternative

Identify any low band width situation and handle the experience gracefully in IE - For low bandwidth scenarios: remove animation

Breakpoint Considerations

Components stack vertically



4 Component Dialog


Press edit to open the dialog and begin editing the component fields.

Configuration Tab


This Tab will contain the overall component configurations and content offerings.

- Configuration Type This drop down allows user to select where they want to pull/create information the options are: using Tags located in etc/tags; Taxonomy by selecting a root folder where all article/report templates will be used by latest created; Selecting the article/report template paths Manually; Or creating the tile content manually
- Header Descriptive title text used for the component
- Tags If user selects "Tags" this will be where user select tags from etc/tags where they have also tagged the specific
 articles/reports
- Titile Open In Option for opening in same window or new tab.
- Select Root Path for Articles/Reports if user selects "Taxonomy" this will be where user selects parent node of article/reports that they want to be shown.
- Title Open In Option for opening in same window or new tab.
- Select Articles/Reports Manually Configuration if user selects "Select Articles/Reports Manually" this multifield will allow user to add multiple tiles
- Path This will be the path of the article/report that the user wants to grab information from
- Open In Option for opening in same window or new tab.
- Create Articles/Reports Manually Configuration if user selects "Enter Articles/Reports Manually" this multifield will
 allow user to add multiple manual tiles
- Title text to describe the article/report
- Title URL link to the article/report
- Title Open In Option for opening in same window or new tab.
- Read Time Length of article/report read time should be in XX min format or 10+ if longer than 10 min.
- Background Image Image that will display on the tile


Tags Dialog




Taxonomy Dialog
