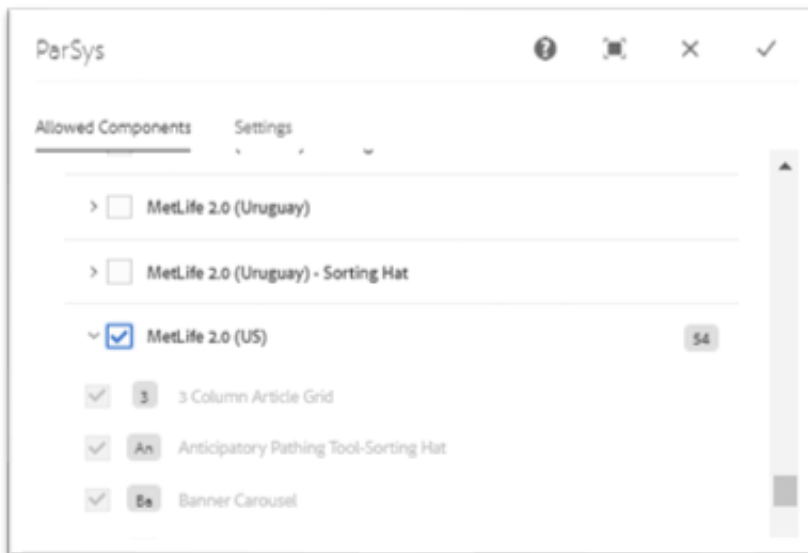

If it is still not available, then it can be enabled by going to the *Design mode* of the page and click *Configure* button on any prays and select from the list of available components (MetLife 2.0 based on the market), and click on ✓ symbol to complete the selection.

- Select Edit to open the dialog box and begin editing the component fields.

Feature Overview

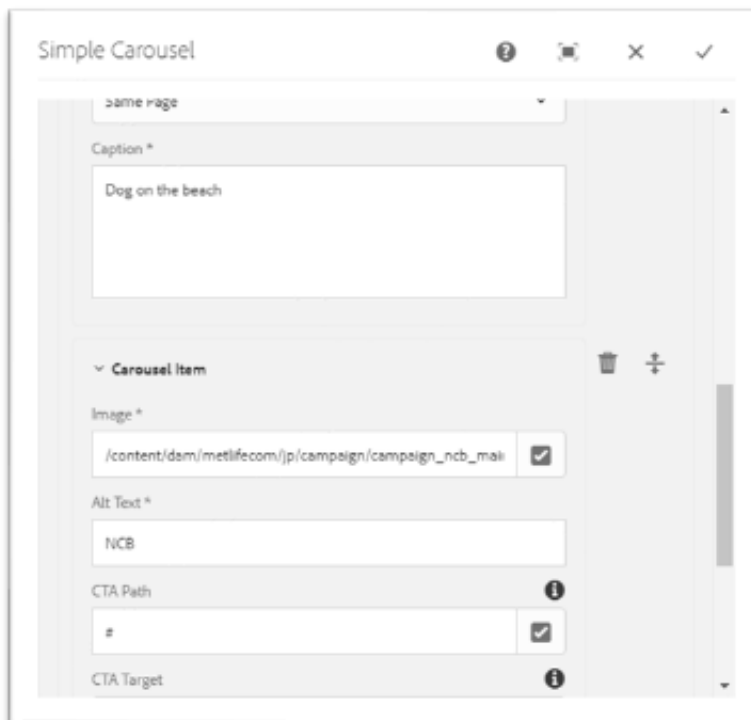
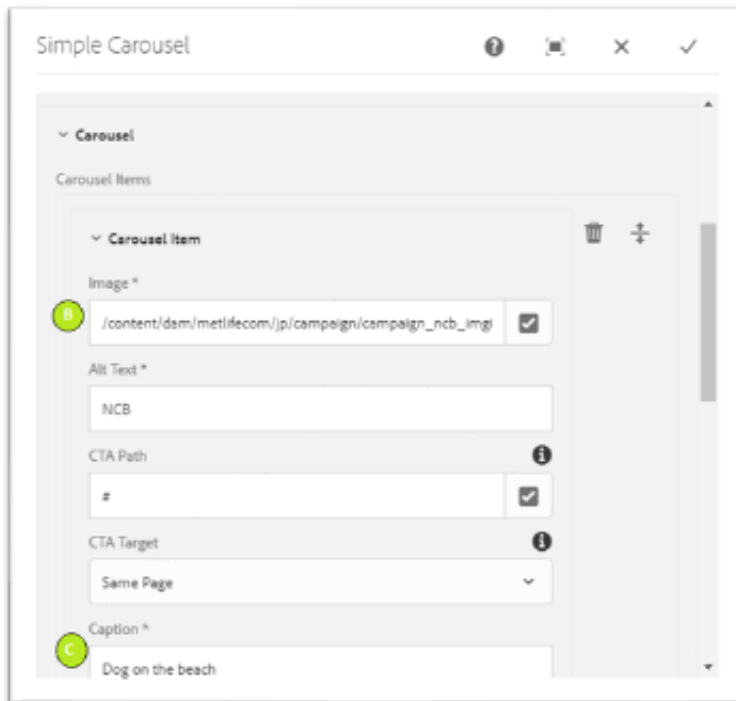
Configuration

1. **Image Aspect Ratio** – Must select an appropriate Aspect Ratio from the dropdown for the images.
2. **Caption Configuration** – Must select an appropriate mode from the dropdown.
3. **Single Caption** – This field is enabled only when Single is selected in Caption Configuration tab.
Must Provide an appropriate caption for all the images.
4. **Image** – Provide an image path.
5. **Alt Text** – Provide a meaningful alternate text for the image.
6. **CTA Path** – Provide the link path for the image.
7. **CTA Target** – Select the dropdown value as 'Same Page' or 'New Page'.
8. **Caption** – This field is enabled only when Multiple is selected in Caption Configuration tab.
- Must Provide an appropriate caption for each image.

There are three variations for this component.

Variation 1: Simple Carousel with A Caption for Each Slide

This Mode can be enabled by selecting 'Multiple' from Caption Configuration tab.

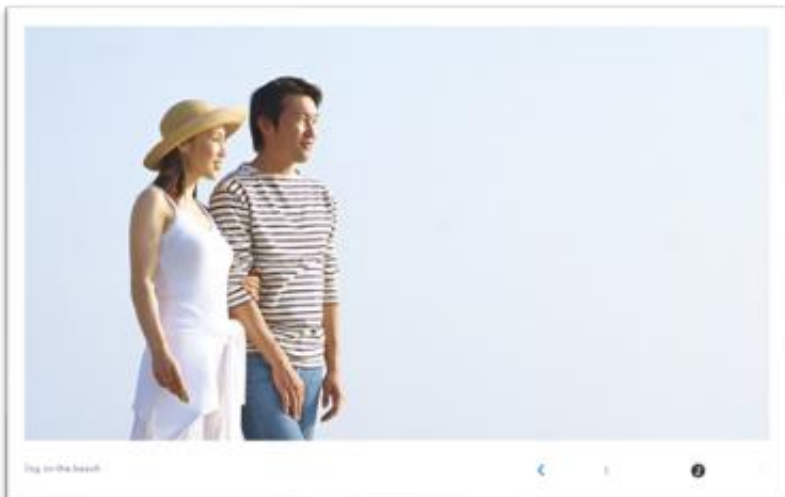
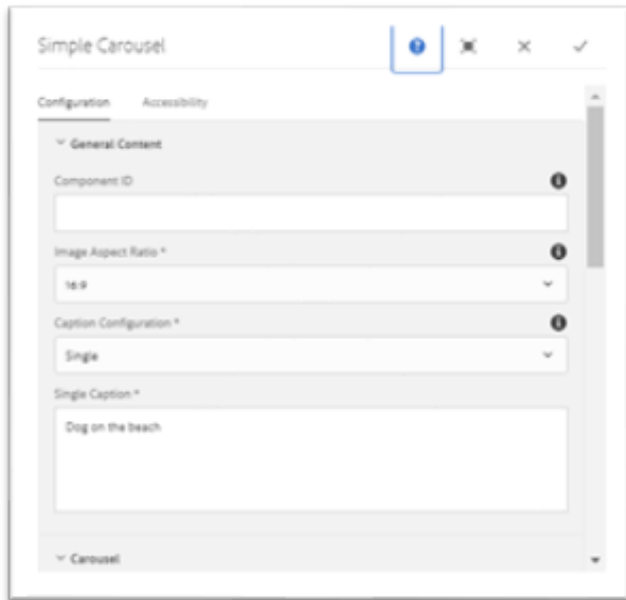
