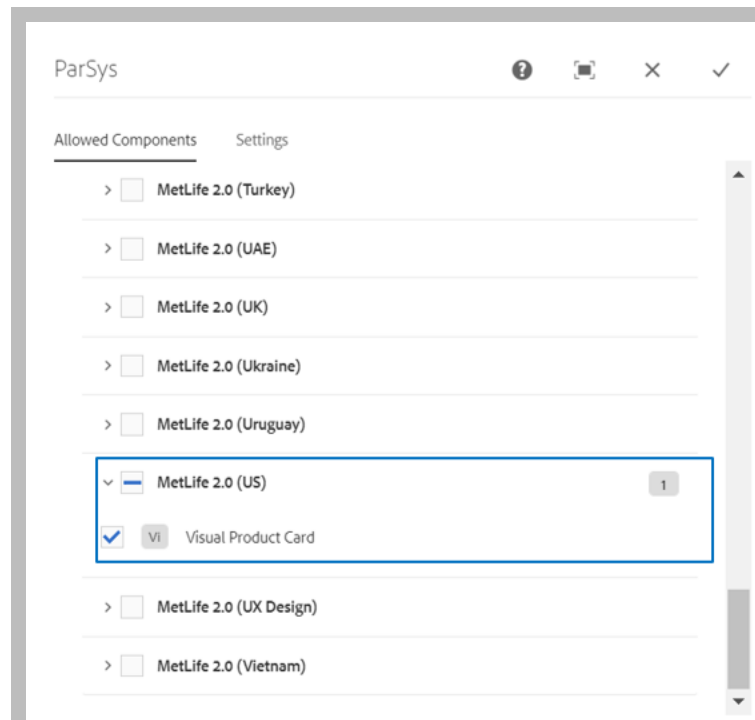

3 How to Enable/Turn-On the Component

This component should be available by default when the Evolution set up is enabled on a page. If it is still not available, then it can be enabled by going to the *Design mode* of the page and click *Configure* button on any prays and select from the list of available components (MetLife 2.0 based on the market) and click on ✓ symbol to complete the selection.



4 Component Dialog

- Right click the component and click edit to open the dialog and begin editing the component fields.

Configuration Tab

This Tab will contain the overall component configurations and content offerings as follows:

1. Image Type – Image type can be image or Icon. Appropriate type can be selected from the dropdown
2. Supporting Copy – Enable/Disable Supporting copy by selecting the option from the dropdown
3. Background Color – Select the background of the layout from the dropdown (Gray/Gradient)
4. Component ID – Provide unique Id for the component without any blank spaces
5. Eyebrow – The Eyebrow text referring to the category can be configured here
6. Title – Title of card to portray to user
7. Supporting Copy – Descriptive information to portray to user
8. URL – Link for Visual Product Card
9. Open In – Option for opening in same window or new tab
10. Image – Image shown to user across desktop and all devices
11. Alt Text – Alt text for image
